

# LIBRARY




The Library is open to all visitors to the APPCIOS community website and it contains a wide range of material we hope will be of interest. This includes links to relevant written material in the public domain and articles or papers by members of the organisation.

We are constantly adding to our library, with over 24 papers added this year and, in total, 125 papers, articles and videos available in the library appealing to anyone interested in looking at society and human relationships through a psychodynamic lens. We currently have 25 shelves covering a wide range of areas.

It is important to us that the content reflects what concerns readers most about the world in which they work and live at the moment. With that in mind, we have included papers on such topics as Democracy in the Western World, Climate Change, Artificial Intelligence, Loneliness, Psychodynamic thinking in schools (including boarding schools), Adult ADHD, Gender Identity, Conspiracy Theories, Fundamentalism and, especially, Organisational dynamics – there are many more topics of interest so we invite you to take a look.

# REFLECTIVE PRACTICE


The Reflective Practice Group provides a supportive space for psychodynamic practitioners to share experiences and discuss various, and varied, aspects of consulting.
